

## JASPER STRASSENFEST - RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dates: August 5, 6, 7, & 8 - 2010
2. Hours: Thursday and Friday.....5:00 p.m. - 12:00 midnight  
Saturday 11:00 a.m. - 12:00 midnight  
Sunday 12:00 noon - 3:00 p.m. (optional for booths beginning in 2003)
3. Set-Up and Tear-Down Times: **Set-up Time will be on Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. (*and not before*)** until Thursday in order to be ready to open your booth at 5:00 p.m. Thursday. Tear-down may begin after 4:30 p.m. Sunday (*and not before*) and **MUST** be completed by Sunday evening. All booths must be prepared to operate the hours stated above in section 2. Booths may choose not to open at all on Sunday, but tear down *may not* begin prior to 4:30 p.m. on Sunday. Please advise ALL members of your organization of these set-up and tear-down hours and times of operation. Adhere to the times allowed!
4. Use of the Strassenfest Logo/Lettering: Must have prior approval from the Strassenfest Committee.
5. Distribution of Receipts: In order for the Strassenfest Committee to provide top-notch entertainment, publicity, electricity, insurance etc. an income is necessary. This year each booth will return 15% of its gross receipts to the Committee. A \$25.00 NON-REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEE FOR EACH BOOTH IS REQUIRED BY APRIL 30th. THIS ENTRY FEE IS IN ADDITION TO THE 15%.. A \$10.00 Entry Fee is required for table display entries. All monies due to the Strassenfest Committee must be paid by the 10th day in September or a monthly service charge (amount to be decided by the Committee) will be billed to any organization not meeting this deadline.
6. Make all checks payable to: Jasper Strassenfest, Inc., P.O. Box 307, Jasper, IN 47547-0307.
7. Booth Design: All booths must be constructed using the design supplied by the Committee, which is available upon request.  
Colors are as follows: Frame – red, Counters – yellow, Signs – Black & yellow, Top of booth tarp – yellow. German-style decorations are encouraged and PERSONS WORKING IN THE BOOTHS ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR GERMAN-STYLE CLOTHING. *MAKE THIS FUN FOR OUR VISITORS!*
8. Electricity: Electricity up to the booth will be provided by the Committee. Each booth must be pre-wired with a 220/110 volt fused or circuit breaker panel that will service your own electrical needs. If you require lights only, a 110V fuse will suffice. Any additional electrical requests or requirements are at your expense. It is required to have light guards for overhang bulbs – each bulb must have a protective light guard.
9. Rubbish and Trash Removal: All booths will be responsible for the removal of trash and rubbish from around their booth each night. All participants should comply with State Board of Health requirements. Food stands must have a permit, which can be obtained from the County Health Department on south St. Charles St. in Jasper. Each booth is also required to have one (1) 33 gallon trash can – liners will be supplied by the Strassenfest Committee. Foods booths must use cardboard or other materials on the ground to eliminate grease problems.
10. Structural Work must meet the approval of the Strassenfest Committee.
11. Insurance: If insurance against loss of any nature is desired, it must be obtained and carried by the exhibitor. The Strassenfest Committee's insurance policy does not cover your organization or booth.
12. No "Silly String" and/or similar product can be sold or given away as prizes.
13. No Soliciting or selling through the crowd without the approval of the Strassenfest Committee.
14. Fire Extinguisher: All booths are REQUIRED to have an extinguisher (must be 2A 10BC). Deep frying booths must also have a 40 Rated BC, for possible cooking or electrical fires (total of 2 fire extinguishers). All extinguishers must be mounted (not on the floor) and have a properly dated inspection label. Propane (and any pressurized) tanks must be secured and placed outside of booth. The committee (and the Jasper Fire Chief and the State Fire Marshal) will be checking each booth to make sure you are in compliance.
15. A Copy of the Rules and Regulations is to be posted in each booth. Committee will be checking for these.
16. Booth Operators shall be non-profit organizations that serve Jasper or Dubois County.
17. Duplication: As of the 1990 Strassenfest, all items sold by new booths and additions to existing booths are subject to Committee approval. Duplication of items is not allowed.
18. Adult Supervision: An adult must be present in all booths during operating hours.
19. Smoking: Smoking is not allowed in booths. No smoking signs must be posted in all booths.
20. Exit signs (in the beer garden) must be illuminated.
21. Fire Resistant Tarps: All cooking booths must have a fire resistant tarp. The identification label must be attached to the tarp and visible to the inspector. Cardboard is not permitted in the ceiling area of the booth. Cardboard may be used for comfort on pavement – but must be changed/removed when grease-filled.
22. There must be a standard first-aid kit in each booth.
23. Non-Compliance with the above rules can result in a monetary fine, expulsion from this and/or future Strassenfest's, and/or any other disciplinary action agreed upon by the Strassenfest Committee.
24. All Matters Not Covered in these rules and regulations are subject to the decision of the Jasper Strassenfest Committee. The Strassenfest Chairman has the final decision in all matters.
